



## **STATEMENT ON INDONESIAN EARTHQUAKE AND TSUNAMI**

**October 2, 2018**

Our hearts are heavy watching the news of the devastating earthquake and tsunami in Indonesia, which has taken the lives of nearly 1,350 people so far. Many organizations, including World Central Kitchen and Save the Children, are providing much-needed food, shelter and basic goods to survivors.

In a joint effort with All Hands and Hearts and local partners, World Central Kitchen, a group of chefs creating smart solutions to hunger and poverty, has established a central relief kitchen in the northwestern part of Lombok and its volunteers are serving thousands of meals to survivors.

Save the Children, an international children's agency, has an emergency response team on the ground and is setting up child-friendly spaces in shelters for those who have lost their homes and will supply diapers and cribs.
